Historical organ manufactured by Estey Organ Co, Brattleboro, Vermont in the USA circa early 1920s.

It is believed that the organ was used in the former Recreation Hall (now Building 'O') for dances which were held weekly for staff and residents as well as the local community. Entertainment was often provided by local church bands and choirs. The program was principally composed of musical selections. The instrument may also have been used in religious services.

The Recreation Hall has been adapted by USQ for use as a lecture theatre.
