## A message from the Chancellor

Dear colleagues,

University Council had its second meeting of 2025 on 14 April. Prior to the meeting, Council and the Vice-Chancellor's Executive (VCE) attended a joint workshop, facilitated by the Acting Director (Internal Audit) Kris Isles, to review the University's risk appetite and tolerance statements. This workshop provided a valuable opportunity for Council and VCE to confirm shared understanding of risk in the context of the current operating environment.

Council member Amanda Kenafake and I have continued to participate as members of the Shaping Our Future Steering Committee, attending fortnightly meetings, receiving information about the various programs of work underway and providing input and advice on behalf of Council. The Deputy Chancellor and I also continue our weekly meetings with Professor Nelson, with the aim of ensuring the effective partnership between the senior executive and Council as the University undergoes this necessary transformation.

I can also advise that the process of recruitment to the position of Vice-Chancellor has progressed, with a provider to undertake the executive search service procured, and the make-up of selection panel endorsed by Council. As per the Charter of University Governance, the panel includes the Chancellor, Deputy Chancellor and Chair of Academic Board as ex officio members, an independent member of Council, and a co-opted external member.
