

If the emergency is life-threatening call 000, followed by (07) 4631 2222

Code Red (Fire)



- Remove people from danger (if it is safe to do so)
- If the alarm has not activated, activate a break glass alarm or the SafeZone mobile app
- Follow warden instructions
- Evacuate via nearest emergency exit to your closest assembly area

Code Orange (Evacuation)



- Stop work immediately
- Follow warden instructions
- Evacuate the building following your evacuation diagram
- Go to the assembly area and await further instruction from the Chief Warden

Code Blue (Medical Emergency)



- Call **000** if the situation is life-threatening, If not life threatening, call **07 4631 2222** or activate the SafeZone mobile app
- Provide first aid if trained
- For poisoning, call Poisons Information on **13 11 26**

Code Yellow (Internal Emergency)



- Chemical spill, gas/water leak or power failure
- Evacuate or isolate area and stop people from entering the affected area
- Call **07 4631 2222** or activate the SafeZone mobile app

Code Brown (External Emergency)



- Natural disaster, external bush fire, earthquake, flooding, major road accident, aircraft crash etc
- Assess situation; do not enter danger area
- Call **07 4631 2222** or activate the SafeZone mobile app.
- Provide first aid if trained and required

Code Purple (Bomb or Substance Threat)



- Do not touch suspicious items
- Isolate area and keep people away
- Call **07 4631 2222** or activate the SafeZone mobile app.
- Follow Campus Security and Police instructions

Code Black (Armed Offender)



- **Escape:** if it is safe to do so - take your mobile phone with you if you can
- **Hide:** silence your phone, lock/barricade the immediate area, stay quiet
- **Tell:** call 000 then **07 4631 2222** when safe
