### Campus Security Updates

A reminder to remain alert when traveling around campus or to neighbouring properties. Reports have been received of disruptive behaviour towards staff and students by community members and while Campus Security is monitoring the situation, they are unable to respond beyond the campus boundaries. This behaviour is intermittent and appears to occur predominantly during school holiday periods (upcoming 27 June-12 July).

Campus Security continue to provide safety escort services within the campus upon request (subject to guard availability) and SafeZone is also available to report security concerns or request assistance. Instructions on how to download SafeZone are available [here](#).

On a separate note, as part of continuous improvement activities, minor edits to the [Physical Security Procedure](#) have been published. These updates provide clarity on Lockdown and Prohibited Weapons procedures across the sites and aligns with the approach of other Universities.
