And it doesn't stop there - salaries tend to grow over time, with graduates seeing an average increase of 88% in the decade after finishing university.<sup>1</sup>


## It's easier to find full-time work throughout your life

## New UniSQ Ipswich building to grow health workforce

UniSQ Ipswich is the region's destination for healthcare education, with increased program offerings, strong community and industry partnerships, and world-leading health research. A new three-storey building, currently under construction and due for completion in 2026, will accommodate the significant growth in School of Health and Medical Sciences students and provide more space for learning, teaching, and research. The new building will bring together the University's teaching and research in key health areas, including occupational therapy, speech pathology and physiotherapy, as well as sport and exercise, paramedicine, nursing and midwifery, and biomedical sciences.

Key features of the new building include:

- technologically enabled, flexible teaching spaces for all programs
- cutting-edge exercise and sporting facilities and equipment
- state-of-the-art PC2 laboratory facilities for medical sciences teaching and research
- dedicated areas for students to connect and collaborate.








## UniSQ shuttle bus service


