Graduates with a bachelor's degree typically have access to a wider range of job opportunities and as a result, can earn more. The median weekly income for degree holders is \$1,500, compared to just \$934 for those without formal qualifications.¹



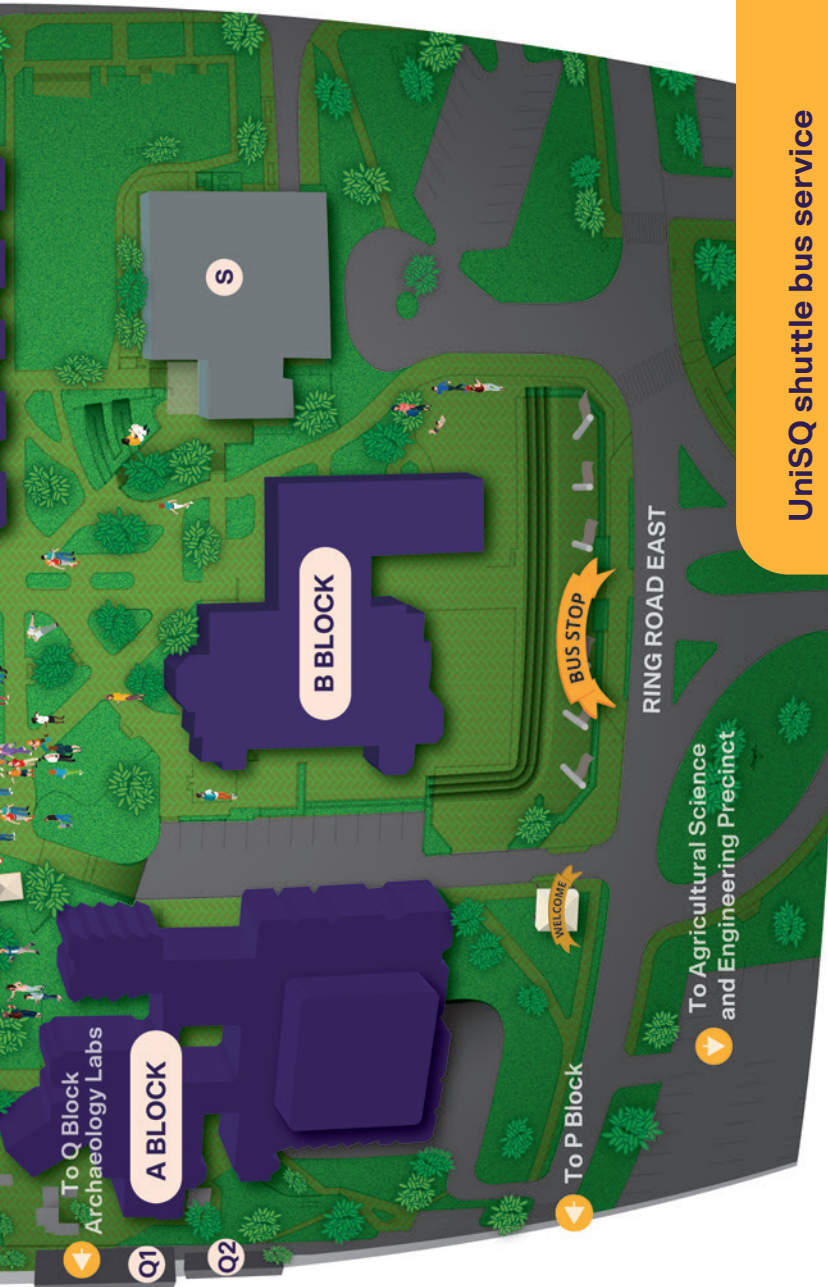
