Program Guide

About Your Program

This Bachelor of Education (Secondary) (BSED) guide contains all the information that you need to know about your program. The BSED is a 32 credit point (32 course) program, and also requires the completion of at least eighty (80) days of supervised professional experience and the [Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education \(LANTITE\)](#). Successful completion of all of the requirements for your program, including passing both the literacy and numeracy tests are required prior to graduation from the program and eligibility to apply for registration as a teacher with the Queensland College of Teachers (QCT). It is your responsibility to register and complete your LANTITE tests prior to graduation.

Students Commencing in 2024 and beyond

As a new student or continuing student who commenced your BSED in 2024 or later, you will follow the enrolment patterns outlined below. Note that we are transitioning from an earlier program, so some of your courses may not be available until 2026, but this is planned for in the enrolment pattern. We strongly recommend you follow your selected pattern closely to ensure a timely completion of your degree.

The recommended enrolment pattern is shown for eight courses per year with study in all three trimesters. We also provide a 4+4 pattern.

Continuing Students who commenced in 2023 or earlier

All successfully completed courses in 2023 or earlier will contribute to your program and you will continue studying as normal.

The transition plan lets you know the last offer of the old courses and the first offer of the new courses so if you miss the last offer of a course that currently appears on your enrolment pattern you will immediately transition into the new course.

The transition plan also lets you know when courses are offered (e.g. T1, T2 or T3) which will assist you to plan your enrolment for the remainder of your program.

If you have not already completed your curriculum & pedagogy courses, you will immediately transition into the new course. (e.g. if you have not studied EDS4402 for your “maths” teaching area, you will immediately transition because you will take EDS2202 in T2)

Please follow the step-by-step guide to build your personalised enrolment pattern.

Section 1: Teaching Areas and Curriculum & Pedagogy Courses

BSED students study discipline courses which qualify you in two teaching areas that are taught in Secondary Schools. You can take any combination of teaching areas except both Design Pathways e.g. either the *Design: Industry (ITD) Pathway* or the *Design: Creative Pathway*.

The courses for your Teaching Area discipline content knowledge are listed for each of your secondary teaching areas in the UniSQ Handbook.

All **students who commenced in 2024 or beyond** will study:

Teaching Area 1

- 6 content knowledge courses
- 1 Junior Curriculum & Pedagogy course
- 1 Senior Curriculum & Pedagogy course

Teaching Area 2

- 5 content knowledge courses
- 1 Junior Curriculum & Pedagogy course
- 1 Senior Curriculum & Pedagogy course

Continuing students from 2023 or earlier should refer to the transition tables below.

Teaching Area and Specialist Courses

Each Secondary teacher will be qualified to teach in two **teaching areas**. Teaching areas are grouped into Key Learning Areas. You need to do both the Junior and Senior Curriculum and Pedagogy courses for each of your Teaching Areas (4 courses total- as above).

If you choose teaching areas that fall under the same Key Learning Area for your teaching area 2 you will undertake the Learning Area Specialist courses. The “Specialist” courses provide students that are specialising within a single Learning Area (ie two senior Sciences, two Humanities, two Social Sciences, two Arts, two Technologies subjects or one Humanities and one Social Science) to develop an advanced understanding of their discipline and explore their second teaching area which is in the same Learning Area.

Examples:

If you choose 2 areas from two *different* curriculum areas: “Mathematics and History”:

Teaching Area 1 - **Mathematics**

Junior Secondary – Mathematics - EDS2202

Senior Secondary – Mathematics - EDS4102

Teaching Area 2 – **History**

Junior Secondary – Humanities - EDS2208

Senior Secondary – Humanities - EDS4108

If you choose 2 areas in the *same* curriculum area: “Chemistry and Biology” (which are both “Sciences”):

Teaching Area 1 – **Chemistry**

Junior Secondary – Science - EDS2203

Senior Secondary – Science - EDS4103

Teaching Area 2 – **Biology**

Junior Secondary – Learning Area Specialist – EDS2200

Senior Secondary – Learning Area Specialist – EDS4100

If you choose 2 areas in the *same* curriculum area: “History and Business” (which are both Humanities and Social Sciences):

3. Select an Enrolment Pattern
 - a. We recommend a 3+3+2 pattern – this allows you to do a full time study load, but spread it across three trimesters.
 - b. We also offer a 4+4 pattern, where you take a full load in two trimesters and have the third trimester free, or do some additional courses to accelerate your studies. If you wish to accelerate, please consult with the Education Discipline Advisor by lodging a request via....

- You will be required to meet any pre-requisites listed in the course specifications to enrol in that course. We strongly encourage you to follow the recommended enrolment pattern to ensure you have completed prerequisite courses.
- You are encouraged to take at least one professional experience course every year and you can not take more than one professional experience course in the same trimester.
