



From Page to Publication

A series of colloquia for Masters, HDR and ECR researchers

You are invited to attend and present an exciting series of four colloquia supported by the PGECR, Phoenix Writers Group and the TEECRAA community focussed on helping you to juice your research and take your research from page to publication.

Each colloquium will run from 9am to 1pm and include a keynote speaker to help build your research, writing skills and knowledge of the publication process; participant presentations with targeted and individualised feedback on your page to publication plan; and opportunities to connect with fellow Masters, HDR and ECR researchers.

Invitations to submit an abstract for a publication you are planning or working on are now open. From there you will be invited to present your research and plan as a 10-minute presentation with 5 minutes of live and personalised feedback at one of the events.
