Bishop George Pell

was born in Ballarat and educated at Loreto Convent and St. Patrick's College, Ballarat. Ordained a Catholic priest in St. Peter's Basilica, Rome in 1966, he returned to Australia in 1971. He has been Director of the Aquinas Campus of the Institute of Catholic Education from 1974-1984 and Principal of the Institute of Catholic Education 1981-1984. He was Rector of Corpus Christi College from 1985-1987. He has a licentiate in theology from Urban University, Rome, a M.Ed. from Monash University and a Doctorate of Philosophy from Oxford University. He was a foundation member of Council of Ballarat College of Education until 1984. He was consecrated an Auxiliary Bishop of Archdiocese of Melbourne on May 21, 1987 and has written widely in religious and secular journals.
