RE-ADMISSION APPLICATIONS

Applications for Re-Admission to Residential Colleges for 1991 can be obtained from Anne Pember at the Warden's Office. Applications must be submitted by *October 20, 1990*.

The main criteria for re-admission into College includes:

- Academic performance determined on the basis of results released by the University.
- As a rule, students remaining incomplete in any enrolled units of the normal unit load will have low priority for re-admission.
- Evidence of successful assimilation into the College environment.
- Under special circumstances (mostly medical) Colleges may offer re-admission on a provisional basis. For example, should a student be unable to appear for formal examinations on medical grounds such a student may be considered for a provisional re-admission to College provided the relevant Resident Fellow was informed of the circumstances at the time and that appropriate medical certificates accompanied the re-admission application.
