## COLLEGE ACTIVITIES

### McGregor

- As a curtain raiser for the Funday Sunday weekend (July 26 to July 28), the Assassin game commenced on Sunday July 21 at midnight and will conclude on Friday 26th in the afternoon at 2.30pm.
- The programme for the Funday Sunday weekend includes:

#### \* Friday July 26 (7.30pm - 1am)

College party, theme of which is "Back to School". Tickets for this event can be purchased for \$3 for RSA members, \$5 for guests from block representatives or the RSA executive.

#### \* Saturday July 27

A car rally commencing at 9am will depart from the entrance to McGregor College and will finish at a mystery destination. A BBQ lunch will take place at the finishing point of the rally. Residents not taking part in the rally can proceed directly to the BBQ location for lunch (the destination will be provided at 11am) or they can have lunch at Steele Rudd College.

The "Old Boys vs Survivors" Touch Football match will commence at 3.30pm on the oval adjacent to McGregor College and behind the Education Centre.

From 7.30pm a "Games Evening" and the Block Banner Competition will take place in the Dining Hall. These events will be followed by a bonfire at which refreshments will be available (coffee, milo, tea, port).

#### \* Sunday July 28

"Champagne & Chicken" breakfast (from 7am) in the McGregor dining

hall. Other food will be provided for persons not able to consume such fare so early in the morning!

After breakfast, until 10.30am, a Scavenger Hunt will take place and will be followed by a McGregor Rural Sunday. This will include a BBQ lunch (12 - 1pm); a variety of novelty events throughout the day (including an ironman/ ironwoman competition) and musical entertainment.

From 7.30pm a "Red Faces" night will be held. Individuals and blocks are invited to present an item/skit etc. At the conclusion of this event a video evening will follow.
