

# HDR Student Thesis Formatting Checklist

## Title Page

- UniSQ logo centred
- Thesis title in uppercase font, centred, 18-point font
- Abbreviations used for qualifications
- Correct award title noted
- Correct year noted
- No page numbers present
- Other text elements set out per template document

## Abstract

- Single paragraph format
- Limited to one page
- Page number in Roman numerals starting at one (i)

## Certification of thesis

- Text as per template; italicized thesis title, correct word limit noted, statement text
- Other text elements as per template document

## Statement of contribution (thesis by publication (TBP) only)

- Text elements as per template document
- Minimum 50% contribution by the student to each paper
- At least one (1) paper has been published
- Number of papers aligns with requirement; typically, three for Doctoral and one for Masters.

## Acknowledgements

- Reference to Australian Government Research Training Program Scholarship (if applicable)
- Reference to UniSQ scholarships (if applicable)

## Table of contents

- Table items for thesis section title are in uppercase font, non-bold, evenly spaced
- Table items for present for all section titles
- Pages numbers are aligned on the right-hand side of the page
- Chapter sub-headers (section headings) in sentence case
- All table times are connected to page numbers by dotted tab
- Chapter 2 is a *literature review*
- (TBP only) Paper Chapters only require table items for the *Introduction* and *Links and implications* sub-headings

## List of Tables

- Table items are formatted as per the template document
- No section titles/sub-heading are present
- No table items included from Paper Chapters

## List of Figures

- Table items are formatted as per the template
- No section titles/sub-heading
- No table items included from Paper Chapters

## Abbreviations

- Formatting aligns with preceding sections

## Chapters

- Section titles are named per the guidelines (Introduction, literature review, ..., discussion and conclusions)
- Section headings format; left aligned, numbered, sentence case, and level 2(+) are italicized
- Page number starts at one (1) using Arabic numbers
- Consistent spacing between text elements (paragraphs, section headings, tables, and figures)
- Tables are fully contained on a single page or have column headers on all subsequent pages
- No orphaned text elements
- Margins are maintained throughout the document

## Paper Chapters (TBP only) – Published, accepted, submitted

- Chapter titled appropriately “Chapter #: Paper #: [Title]” in uppercase font
- Introduction section present
- Papers are inserted exactly as published (PDF), maintaining the thesis margins and page numbers.
- Non-published papers are formatted exactly as submitted; Figures are placed within the text as appropriate, and the paper’s references are listed within the Chapter.
- Links and implications section present

## References

- See the general checks section

## Appendices

- Images and documents inserted whilst maintaining the thesis margins and page numbers.

## General

- Consistent font used throughout thesis
- Page margins of at least 2.5cm on all sides
- All sections are titled as per the guidelines document
- Thesis section titles in uppercase, bold, centred, 12-point font
- Page numbers continue throughout thesis from chapter 1 to final page
