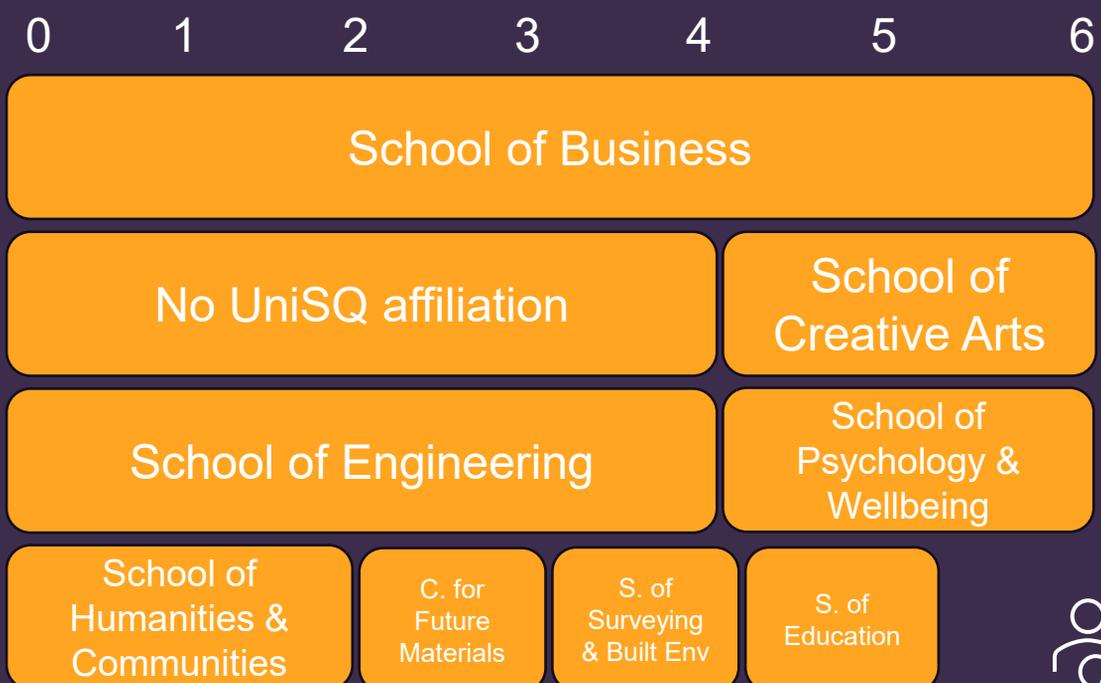
Concern categories

Mitigation of issues identified



Several themes and issues were identified as matters were investigated. Steps taken and in progress include:

Further clarity around conflicts of interest and declarations published on Research Integrity webpage

Clarification of animal ethics complaint management in Animal Ethics Procedure

Authorship Procedure and training revised to clarify when to use UniSQ affiliation

Authorship Agreement and training revised to encourage early and continuing conversations

Peer Review Procedure under development to provide guidance in participating in peer review

Student Academic Misconduct Procedure under revision to include HDR student academic misconduct

Review and renewal of research integrity training materials to promote responsible research

Exploring mechanisms to deliver training in responsible research to Honours students

Requested improvement of ethics management system to facilitate monitoring and reporting
