

AWARD CONDITIONS - 2024

Scott Sargood Memorial Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$4000 to be paid in one instalment.

Additional optional opportunity:

Recipient may also be offered the opportunity to visit the rangelands in coordination with Southern Queensland Landscapes and the Sargood family.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be continuing their studies full-time at UniSQ in the Bachelor of Environmental Science (any major), Bachelor of Science (Environment & Sustainability), or Bachelor of Science (Honours) (Environment & Sustainability), including double degrees programs, in Trimester 1 2024
- have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0 as at the release of results for Semester 2 2023.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for 1 trimester.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - o fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - o does not enrol full-time (minimum 3 study units) in Trimester 1 2024.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the first census date in Trimester 1.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment, as follows:
 - o Trimester 1 \$4000

Additional optional opportunity

Recipient may also be offered the opportunity to visit the rangelands on the Sargood family property. Recipient in their second year can take up this opportunity in their second or third year of study.
