

AWARD CONDITIONS – 2025 Trimester 2

Weis Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$12 000 to be paid over 3 years.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- have commenced, or be commencing their studies full-time at UniSQ in Study Periods 1 or 2 2025 (e.g., Trimesters 1 or 2 2025), in one of the following programs (including double degree programs):
 - Bachelor of Agricultural Technology and Management
 - Bachelor of Science (Animal Science)
 - Bachelor of Science (Food Science)
 - Bachelor of Science (Plant Agricultural Science)
 - Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Agricultural Engineering)
 - Bachelor of Business.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for up to 3 years (not inclusive of any Leave of Absence).
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - changes their program outside of the eligible programs
 - does not enrol in a minimum of 6 study units across each academic year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows: (**see note below)
 - minimum 3 study units in Study Period 1; and
 - minimum 3 study units across Study Periods 2 and 3
 - o defers their program of study
 - o takes more than 12 months total Leave of Absence
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
 - UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

**Applicants commencing their studies at UniSQ in Study Period 2 2025, must be enrolled for their first study period in a minimum of 3 study units.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Study Period 2 2025, and then in Study Period 1 of each year for the remainder of the scholarship.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment each year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - Study Period 1 \$4000 (*Study Period 2 2025 for first instalment*)
- Payment of subsequent instalments will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
