

Bert and Vera Thiess Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$12 000 to be paid over 3 years.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be continuing their studies full-time at UniSQ in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil Engineering) in Trimester 1 2026
- have, as at the release of results for Trimester 3 2025:
 - a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 13 study units completed and credited towards their current program
 - a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- have an income at or below the financial threshold limits.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for up to 3 years (not inclusive of any Leave of Absence).
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - changes their program outside of the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Civil Engineering)
 - does not enrol full-time (minimum of 6 study units) across each academic year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - minimum of 3 study units in Trimester 1; and
 - minimum of 3 study units across Trimesters 2 and 3
 - takes more than 12 months total Leave of Absence
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Trimester 1.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment each year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - Trimester 1 - \$4000

- Payment of subsequent instalments will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
