



Clinical Placement Bursary and Placement Bursary

Value

The bursary value will range from \$250 to \$1000 and will be paid in one instalment.

Eligibility

Placement Bursary recipients must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be commencing or continuing their studies at UniSQ in an undergraduate program in the study period of application (e.g., Trimester 2 2026)
 - continuing students must have a current Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0
- be enrolled in a course with a mandatory placement in the study period of application
- have a low-to-middle annual household income.

Clinical Placement Bursary recipients must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia, or an international on-campus student
- be continuing their studies at UniSQ in the Bachelor of Nursing in the study period of application (e.g., Trimester 2 2026)
- have, as at the release of results for Trimester 1 2026 (for Trimester 2 applications) or Trimester 2 2026 (for Trimester 3 applications):
 - a minimum of 8 study units (or equivalent exemptions) completed and credited towards the Bachelor of Nursing
 - a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0
- be enrolled in a course with a mandatory placement in the study period of application
- attend a placement located more than 80 kms from their term-time address
- have a low-to-middle annual household income.

Conditions

- The duration of the bursary is for the study period in which it is awarded.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the bursary.

Payment

- Payment is made approximately 4 weeks after applications close in the study period of application.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's Australian bank account in one instalment, as follows:
 - \$250 - \$1000, depending on the hours of the placement in the study period of application.
