



AWARD CONDITIONS – 2026 Trimester 2

Greenwood-Tomkys Scholarship in Midwifery

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$8000 to be paid in two instalments.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- have commenced their studies at UniSQ in the Graduate Diploma of Midwifery in Trimester 1 2026
- be enrolled full-time as per the Standard (1 Year) Recommended Enrolment Pattern.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for 1 year.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - changes their program outside of the Graduate Diploma of Midwifery
 - does not enrol full-time across the academic year as per the Standard (1 Year) Recommended Enrolment Pattern
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Trimester 2 and Trimester 3.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in two instalments, as follows:
 - Trimester 2 - \$4000
 - Trimester 3 - \$4000
- Payment of the subsequent instalment will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
