

Kambu Health First Nations Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$6000 to be paid in two instalments.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person of Australia
- be a commencing student
- be intending to enrol full-time at UniSQ in a health service-related associate degree, or bachelor's degree program offered through the School of Health and Medical Sciences, School of Nursing and Midwifery, or School of Psychology and Wellbeing in Trimester 1 2026
- have an income at or below the financial threshold limits.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for up to 1 year.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - changes their program outside of the eligible programs
 - does not enrol full-time (minimum of 6 study units) across the academic year, as follows:
 - minimum 3 study units in Trimester 1; and
 - minimum 3 study units across Trimesters 2 and 3
 - defers their program of study
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Trimester 1 and Trimester 3.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in two instalments, as follows:
 - Trimester 1 - \$3000
 - Trimester 3 - \$3000
- Payment of the subsequent instalment will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
