

AWARD CONDITIONS - 2026

NSW Country Surveyors Association Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$15 000 to be paid in two instalments each year for up to 3 years.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be from a regional, rural or remote area within New South Wales
- be continuing their studies full-time at UniSQ in the Bachelor of Surveying (Honours) in Trimester 1 2026
- have, as at the release of results for Trimester 3 2025:
 - a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 26 study units completed and credited towards their current program
 - o a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0
- not be in receipt of another UniSQ awarded scholarship.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for 1, 2 or 3 years (not inclusive of any Leave of Absence), depending on the number of study units remaining in the recipient's program at the time of award.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - o fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - o changes their program outside of the Bachelor of Surveying (Honours)
 - does not enrol full-time (minimum of 6 study units), across each academic year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - minimum of 3 study units in Trimester 1; and
 - minimum of 3 study units across Trimesters 2 and 3
 - o takes more than 12 months total Leave of Absence
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - o fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- The scholarship will not be paid for any period of study abroad.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.



AWARD CONDITIONS - 2026

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Trimester 1 and Trimester 3.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in two instalments each year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - o Trimester 1 \$2500
 - o Trimester 3 \$2500
- Payment of subsequent instalment(s) will be subject to satisfactory progress in the
 recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the
 scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the
 scholarship should not be cancelled.

Optional Conference Package

The recipient may be offered the opportunity to attend annual conferences with support from NSW Country Surveyors. Further details will follow.
