



Regional Leaders Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$30 000 to be paid over 3 years as a contribution to UniSQ Residential College fees.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be from a regional, rural or remote area of Australia
- have completed Year 12 in 2024 or 2025
- be a new student
- be intending to enrol full-time at UniSQ in a bachelor's degree program in Trimester 1 2026
- be intending to reside at one of the UniSQ Residential Colleges, Toowoomba campus
- be intending to enrol in on-campus mode (unless the program/study units are not offered on-campus).

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for up to 3 years (not inclusive of Leave of Absence).
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - does not enrol full-time (minimum of 6 study units) across the academic year, each year for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - minimum 3 study units in Trimester 1; and
 - minimum 3 study units across Trimesters 2 and 3
 - does not enrol in a minimum of 1 study unit per study period in on-campus mode (unless the program/study units are not offered in on-campus mode)
 - defers their program of study
 - takes more than 12 months total Leave of Absence
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - does not reside at one of the UniSQ Residential Colleges
 - commits serious misconduct including, but not limited to, the provision of false or misleading information
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Trimester 1.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's UniSQ Residential College account in one instalment each year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - Trimester 1 - \$10 000 (to be applied to the recipient's UniSQ Residential College accommodation fees across the year, as appropriate)
- Continuation of fee reduction after the first study period will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
