Eligibility:

- A student that identifies as female
- A student that is currently enrolled in the first-year of an undergraduate program, studying either full-time or part-time, where the award is a bachelor's degree at a tertiary institution
- The student has not previously been awarded a bachelor's degree
- Australian citizen, Permanent Australian Humanitarian Visa holder, Permanent Resident of Australia, Temporary Protection Visa, Temporary Humanitarian Stay Visa or Bridging Visa
- Current residency within the Toowoomba Regional Council area

Selection Criteria:

- personal statement
- intention/motivation for ongoing study and pursuit of an undergraduate degree

Exclusions:

- Students that are currently on a fully funded scholarship

Scholarship Amount:

- A\$1,000 one-off upfront scholarship
