

2026 Donor Scholarship Financial Threshold Limits

Centrelink Income Support Payment:

Applicants who receive a means-tested <u>Centrelink income support payment</u> (e.g., Youth Allowance) automatically meet the financial need criteria of the scholarship.

Non-Centrelink Income Support Payment:

Applicants can demonstrate that their financial circumstances are at or below the limits provided in the table. This is determined based on gross household income as assessed by the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) - Taxable Income. Please be aware that minimum thresholds apply - you may be asked for additional information.

If yours and/or your parents', guardians' or partners' income is slightly higher than the applicable value below, we encourage you to apply as other factors can be taken into consideration.
