Choose the right qualification for you

Unlock a world of opportunity and think big with UniSQ.

From a graduate certificate to a PhD, choose the qualification that suits you best.

Graduate certificate

Add to your resume, enjoy something new and get started in further study with a graduate certificate. Typically made up of four units, a graduate certificate normally takes four to five months to complete.

Graduate diploma

If you're interested in the subjects offered in a masters degree but are unsure about committing to that level of study, a one-year graduate diploma might be right for you. It incorporates the same course options as a graduate certificate, but extends your knowledge further. If you choose to study a masters degree, you may receive credit for subjects you've completed.

Masters (coursework)

A coursework masters takes one to two years of full-time study to complete and is designed to build on existing expertise or develop your knowledge in a new discipline. This is the most common type of masters and involves a combination of lectures, tutorials, project work and research.

Masters (research)

At UniSQ, the Master of Research is a two-year qualification that includes a substantial thesis or research project. Thorough research training is provided and this qualification can be a step towards a PhD.

Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)

A PhD is a doctoral research degree and the highest university qualification. Under appropriate academic supervision, you'll develop a significant and original piece of research in a study area of your choosing. A PhD normally takes between three and four years of full-time study to complete.

Agriculture

Space and Defence

As one of only six Australian trailblazer universities, our global partnerships with NASA, the US Airforce, Boeing and BAE Systems help us to build commercial pathways and have real impact in our communities. We work to ensure our graduates and researchers attain enriching jobs with growth opportunities within the space sector. Manage the cost of study

Study now and pay later – eligible students can access interest-free degrees with no upfront fees.

Postgraduate degree fees are either Commonwealth-supported places or full-fee tuition places.

Commonwealth-supported places are subsidised by the government. A HECS-HELP loan could then allow you to defer the payment of the remaining fees. If the degree requires full-fee payment, financial support is available and eligible domestic students can apply for a FEE-HELP loan.

Research Training Program

The Research Training Program provides government scholarships for most domestic students enrolled in a higher degree by research degree. Learn more about eligibility requirements on our website.

Apply for a scholarship

A scholarship can assist with textbooks, living costs and practical experience expenses. Some scholarships are one-off payments, while others continue for the duration of the degree.

Tax deductions

You may be eligible for tax deductions on tuition fees and study materials if your postgraduate degree relates to your current career.

Recognition of prior work experience and study

Have your work and study experience recognised to reduce the number of courses you need to complete.

Notes

Degrees at UniSQ can be studied at a pace that suits you. In this brochure, we have listed the duration of study in terms of a full-time course load, but part-time study is often an option.

Not all courses in a degree are available in every study period.

Degrees listed are subject to change at the discretion of the University.

Study modes

On-campus students attend lectures, tutorials, workshops and practical sessions in-person at UniSQ Toowoomba, Springfield or Ipswich.

Online study can be from anywhere, all study materials are available through the UConnect student portal and library resources can be delivered.

The **external mode** is a mixed study mode; theoretical subjects are studied online and practical courses are completed on campus through residential schools, or off campus as part of industry placements.

Residential schools provide external students with the opportunity to complete hands-on, practical activities, and attend face-to-face lectures and tutorials.

Placements involve practical work experience. Before commencing a placement, you may be required to provide documentation, certificates, or evidence of immunisations. Sometimes there is a requirement to purchase and wear a uniform. Some degrees have mandatory placements that you need to complete in order to graduate.
