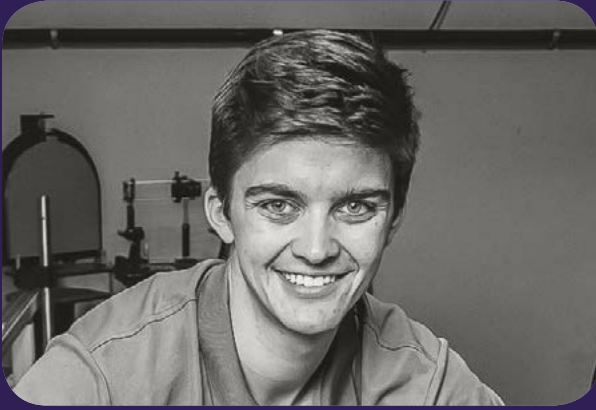

About this guide

This guide provides an overview of all UniSQ postgraduate degrees – there are a few things to be aware of to help you find the perfect qualification for you.

Commonwealth-supported places

Commonwealth-supported places (CSP) have fees that are subsidised by the government. Degrees with CSP have been marked with this icon . To learn more about CSP and managing the cost of study, please see page 31.

Duration

Speed up or slow down your degree to suit your lifestyle. Throughout this guide we have listed degrees in terms of full-time study (unless otherwise stated). Part-time study options are available for most degrees.

Key dates

You can study where and when it suits you. Our degrees are taught in an innovative academic calendar to give you flexibility within your degree and study patterns.

Please note, not all courses are available in every study period. Learn more via unisq.edu.au/key-dates

Study modes

On-campus students attend lectures, tutorials, workshops, and practical sessions in-person at UniSQ Toowoomba, Springfield, or Ipswich and online.

Online study can be from anywhere, all study materials are available through our student portal, and library resources can be delivered.

External is a mixed study mode; course theory is studied online and practical learning is completed on campus through residential schools or off campus as part of industry placements.

Placements

Placements are a form of practical work experience. Before starting a placement, you may need to provide documentation, certificates, or evidence of immunisations. Sometimes there is a requirement to purchase and wear a uniform.

Residential schools

Residential schools provide students with the opportunity to complete hands-on, practical activities, and attend face-to-face lectures and tutorials. Residential schools are held at UniSQ Toowoomba, Springfield, or Ipswich.



The right qualification for you

A postgraduate degree can be your ticket to becoming a leader, earning more, or changing careers.

Graduate certificate

Add to your resume, enjoy something new, or get started in further study with a graduate certificate. Typically consisting of four units, a graduate certificate usually takes four to five months of full-time study to complete and can be a pathway to a graduate diploma or master (coursework).

Graduate diploma

A graduate diploma often takes one year of full-time study to complete and can be a great way to explore your interests before studying a masters. Once you know the topic is right for you, it's easy to apply the credits you received from your graduate diploma to a masters.

Master (coursework)

Build on your expertise or develop your knowledge of a new discipline with a coursework masters. Typically taking one to two years of full-time study to complete, this is the most common type of masters and involves a combination of lectures, tutorials, project work, and research.

Master (research)

If you're interested in completing a PhD, a research masters can be a good way to trial this type of study and build your research skills. Our Master of Research is a two-year qualification that includes a substantial thesis or research project.

Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)

Help advance society's collective knowledge and make your mark in your chosen field with a PhD. This doctoral research degree is the highest university qualification. With supervision and support from expert academics, you'll develop a significant and original piece of research. A PhD typically takes three to four years of full-time study to complete.

Manage the cost of study

When considering postgraduate study it's important to know degrees either require full-fee payment or are Commonwealth-supported. There are many ways to manage your tuition costs including scholarships, loans, and tax deductions.

Commonwealth-supported places

Commonwealth-supported places (CSP) are subsidised, the Australian Government shares the cost of your study by paying part of your fees directly to the University. Students in CSP pay a reduced fee called a 'student contribution' and eligible students may defer this portion of their fees to a HECS-HELP loan. CSP are only available to eligible domestic students.

When you are accepted to study with UniSQ, we will indicate if you have been offered a Commonwealth-supported place.

Throughout this guide degrees with CSP have been marked with this symbol . Learn more via unisq.edu.au/csp

HECS-HELP loan

A HECS-HELP loan can allow you to defer the remaining cost of study if you are enrolled in a Commonwealth-supported place. To be eligible for this loan you must meet certain criteria. Learn more via unisq.edu.au/hecs-help

FEE-HELP loan

A FEE-HELP loan defers the payment of tuition fees for domestic students enrolled in degrees that require full-fee payment (i.e. those without CSP). Learn about eligibility criteria and more at unisq.edu.au/hecs-help

Research Training Program

The Research Training Program provides government scholarships for most domestic students enrolled in higher degrees by research. Learn more via unisq.edu.au/research-study

Scholarships
