We're blazing trails to space and beyond



UniSQ has been named one of Australia's Trailblazer universities to accelerate growth in space manufacturing and lead a new research hub of national priority.

Out of six projects chosen to supercharge Australia's world-class research and innovation capabilities, UniSQ was named in half, making it the only university in Australia to be part of three initiatives.

UniSQ is already a world leader in space manufacturing and was awarded the \$50 million Trailblazer grant for the Innovative Launch, Automation, Novel Materials, Communications and Hypersonics (iLAUNCH) Hub. This Hub will develop a space manufacturing precinct in the region, provide \$3.65 billion in economic benefits, 20 000 jobs and develop a Space Engineering degree to ensure our expertise continues to grow.

UniSQ was also named as a partner in the University of Queensland-led Food and Beverage Accelerator project, and Deakin University's Recycling and Renewable Energy Commercialisation Hub (REACH) project.

Working collaboratively with partners, both locally and internationally, our research and training strives to deliver outcomes the world needs. And while the work we do stretches across a broad number of disciplines, our researchers are united by the same drive to deliver incredible progress



Academic Excellence Scholarships

The UniSQ Academic Excellence Scholarships are automatically awarded to eligible Year 12 Students who put UniSQ as #1 on their QTAC application for 2022 and achieve the required ATAR.
